HANDLING & STORAGE TIPS

Avoid touching the printed surface. Fingerprints may deteriorate the print quality, and some papers can be scuffed or scratched quite easily.



- Wearing cotton gloves is recommended while handling the prints.
- Do not expose the print to extreme temperatures or humidity.
- ✓ Avoid folding or rolling the print. (Gently rolling a print not less than 5" in diameter is acceptable for short periods, such as shipping or transporting to a framer. Roll prints with their natural curve)
- ✓ Unframed prints stored long-term should be placed in a polyethylene plastic sleeve. Any stiffening board or other materials should be archival and acid-free. (We use ArchivalMethods.com & ClearBags.com)
- Avoid storing your prints in a room where paints, varnishes, or any solvents are used.
- Ideally, displayed prints should be professionally framed and matted so the print is not in contact with the glass. We recommend opting for UV protective glass.
